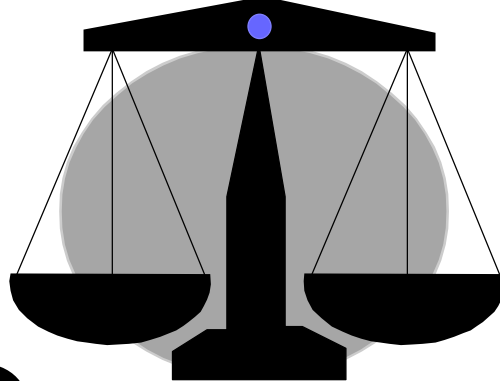

The Program...

Deposition Practice and Procedure is designed to train attorneys in the skills involved in taking and defending depositions. This intensive two-day course utilizes team teaching in a workshop format. Our outstanding faculty will present lectures on how to prepare and depose witnesses, offering their unique insights and practice tips. Participants will then be divided into opposing "teams" using a mock case file and will have the opportunity to prepare a witness for deposition, as well as take or defend a portion of a deposition of a party and expert witnesses. Each participant will present two live exercises daily and be critiqued by the faculty. Videotapes of each participant's performances will be made and also critiqued daily. Admission to the bar is required, and enrollment is limited. This is a unique experience to learn deposition skills through lecture and performance under the guidance of experienced lawyers who generously devote their time to serve as members of our faculty.
